- Precision Rifle Works operates on an Appointment ONLY basis. Since the shop is out of our home, any customer that does not have an appointment will NOT be assisted.
- Please make sure all firearms are unloaded UNLESS they are coming in to remove a jam. If jammed with a live round in the chamber, make sure the firearm is always pointed in a safe direction and handled with extreme caution.
- Please bring your Drivers License or valid government issue ID with your current address or a change of address card. These will be used to book in your firearms.
- If your firearm needs to be test fired, you are welcome to drop off your own ammunition as long as it is factory produced in the original packaging. Reloads or hand loads of any kind will not be accepted.
- We highly recommend that you bring your firearm in a case. However, due to our limited space, cases cannot stay with the firearm.

- Our road turns into a private, gravel road and for this reason, winter pick ups and drop offs may be difficult for those without 4 wheel drive.
- When you arrive, please pull in or back down the driveway with the address posted. As the driveway is a little long and steep, it can be difficult to back out of.
- Please be respectful and vigilant as we have two young children, two dogs, and chickens that may sometimes wander.
- Upon drop off, if you would like a receipt of the items left with Precision Rifle Works, please let me know at the time of drop off and one can be typed up and emailed to you.
